

Response to TODAY Online Voices: IPs provide Covid-19 hospitalisation coverage for Singapore travellers upon their return

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We refer to the <u>letter</u> by Mr Wong Chin Kiat ("Insurers should provide coverage for S'pore travellers who get COVID-19 after returning from trips", Feb 22).

We would like to clarify that all integrated shield plans (IPs) cover inpatient medical bills for policyholders should they be infected with COVID-19 upon returning from overseas trips and require hospitalisation as a result.

Coverage is provided regardless of vaccination status, and regardless of whether or not travel was via a Vaccinated Travel Lane.

We encourage policyholders to <u>contact</u> their IP insurer should they have further questions or concerns.
